3. What are they going to do first?

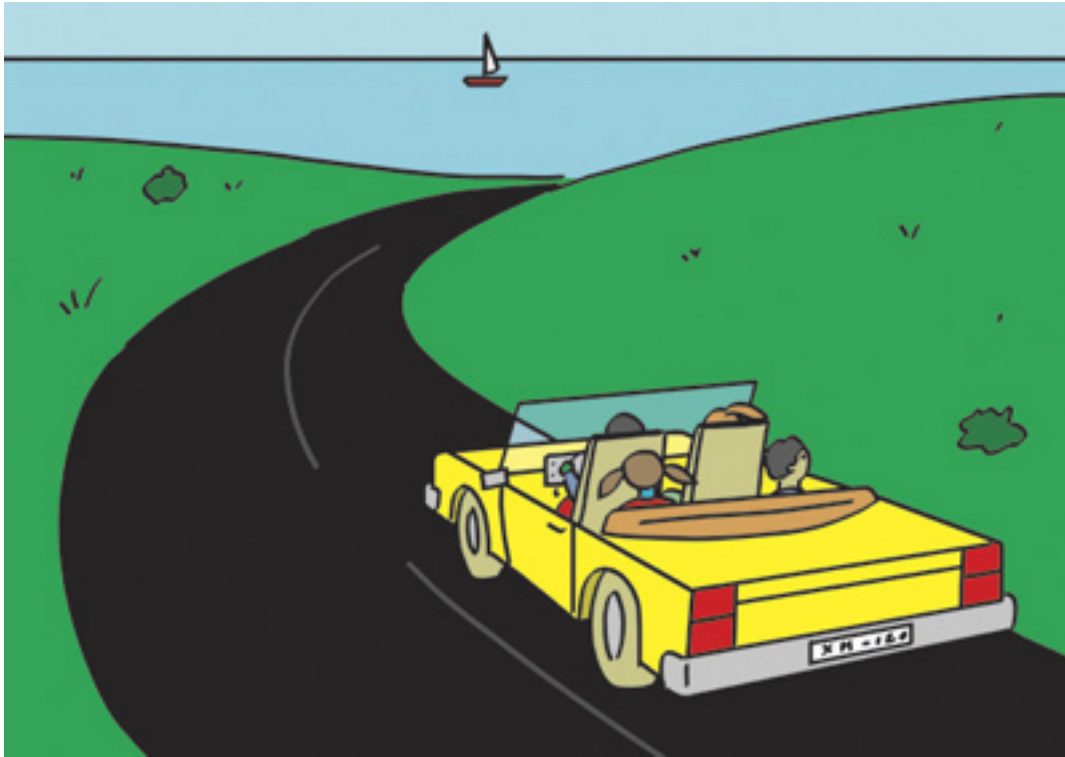

6. How is Julie going to get dressed up?

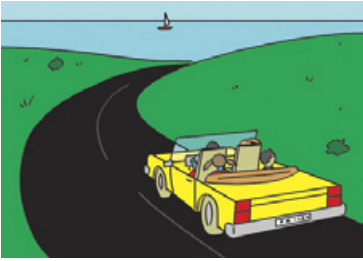
